Why should I apply?

What can I expect from the programme?

If you are selected, you'll have access to a mentoring programme where brilliant women at FARFETCH who are involved in projects that are effectively changing the future of an entire industry will be able to support you in your studies and share their real-world knowledge and experiences. You will also have the opportunity to connect with a global, passionately collaborative community.

What are the main selection criteria for the programme?

We are looking for young women who are interested in pursuing a career in STEM so that we can help you foster your potential throughout your studies. We will also take into consideration your interests, achievements and extracurricular activities, such as entrepreneurship experiences, sports practice or volunteering. Finally, the creativity and uniqueness of your answers will also be taken into consideration.

What are the target areas of study of the candidates?

Our Mentors' main areas of expertise are Technology and Product, so we believe the programme will be more effective if the mentees are interested in enrolling in similar areas in the future, working hands-on within a STEM field. Therefore, we will consider candidates that want to apply or that are enrolled in university degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics.

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Will there be an extension of the deadline for submission?

No, there will be no extensions on the application deadline. You should submit your application on or before April 8th at 23:00 GMT.

How will I know if my application has been received?

An email will be sent to you after the application is submitted.

Can I submit my application in a language other than English?

Please submit the application form and video interview in English — we'll not be able to consider applications in other languages at this time.

How will the selection process occur?

If you consider you fit the requirements for the programme, you should submit your application through our Careers site and answer the questions you will find there. Once we receive your application, you will get an email confirming it, asking you to complete a short video interview (up to 10 minutes) on myInterview. You should follow that link and record yourself answering the questions asked on this platform. We will then analyze all applications and video interviews and provide feedback to all applicants until the end of March.

What is myInterview?

myInterview is the platform we will use for you to answer a few brief questions about your motivations and aspirations, your interest in this programme and your potential fit to FARFETCH values and culture. This will be a video interview, so you will be asked to record yourself providing these answers, but you have the freedom to be creative in the way you do so. We just want to get to know you better and learn more about you.
